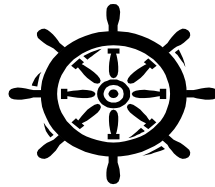

Fabric needed 4 different material to cut 16 wedges(4 from each fabric) 5 inches X 9 inches

1 -12 inch square for center

1 - 25 inch square for backing (can be pieced)

1 –piece batting 25 inch square

fusible web

freezer paper
