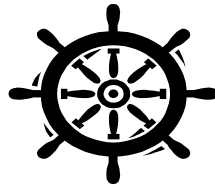

February 16, 2010- Demo Lynn's Purse

PROJECT: LYNN'S PURSE

TAUGHT BY: Lynn Otwell 540-937-0304

DESCRIPTION: Make a 10" x 11" x 3 1/2" pocketbook as directed in the pattern or buy a little extra fabric, lining and batting to make a larger size. You can even make a smaller size. A wallet pattern is included also, however, it will not be taught. Grommets for the purse are available at both Joanne and Wal-Mart's. Optional pockets may be added. This stylish bag will become a necessity and you'll be proud to say that you "made it yourself."

SUPPLY LIST: 2 Fat Quarters

Fabric handles: 3/8 yard

OR Ribbon Handles 3/4 yd of 1 1/2" - 2 1/2" wide

Fusible Fleece for fabric handles: 1 piece 3" x 41"

Lining 3/8 yard

Batting (fusible if you can get it) 13" x 27"

Bag Bottom - 3 1/2" x 9" cardboard, Timtex or Pell Tex

4 large grommet sets: 1 9/16" (size shown)

OPTIONAL : Substitute batting or stabilizer for handles

Specialty threads, trims for bag decoration

NOTES: The pattern will be distributed on Feb 16 at the Demo. You can bring your machine and make the bag at the workshop or watch the demo and make on your own. Whatever you do-- ENJOY!
